

You can also make you own inlay powder in a variety of colors. I got this recipe for a guy that rebuilds crashed or damaged airplanes.

Put 1/4 cup of baking powder (not soda) in a small ziplock bag. Add several drops of food color and mix well by squeezing the bag until the drops are mixed well into the powder. The more drops you use the deeper the color. Then use it just like you would any inlay. The baking powder may smoke a little when you first put in the CA, but doesn't hurt anything. Just don't breathe it.

You can use the basic colors or...

Here's my color chart by drops for unusual colors:

Orange: 1 red 2 yellow

Chartreuse: 12 yellow 1 green

Peach: 1 red, 3 yellow

Turquoise: 5 blue 1 green

Purple: 1 red 1 blue

Rose: 5 red 1 blue

If you didn't get the color you wanted add more drops. I'll sometimes add in various wood chips or acrylic chips to get different effects as well.
